BOOKS

HCC's book program provides students with cost-effective and easily accessible course textbooks. Students will incur a fee of \$20 per credit hour for course textbooks and materials. Most courses utilize digital content through the Canvas classroom using RedShelf Course Materials. Some courses require physical textbooks to be mailed to the student. Communication will be sent to students who need to place a Bookstore order for mailed materials.

Some courses require supplemental or consumable materials. The cost of these items will be added to the course as an additional fee. These materials will be distributed through RedShelf or by HCC email after classes begin. Courses with fees are identified with +.

CREDIT LOAD
